Many nouns can be easily changed into both adjectives and adverbs by simply adding suffixes. We know the most frequent suffix to change to an adverb is -ly. But, an noun can be changed to an adjective by adding suffixes such as -al, -ful, -ical, -like, -ous, -y. (You can check MY website for some help on this if you need it.)

Now, you create some examples, and write a sentence using the form indicated. For example: beauty/beautiful/beautifully/The beauty of the painting inspired many young artists./The beautiful sunset was the perfect backdrop for the wedding./The pianist played the piece beautifully.
