Proper Nouns

While a noun names a person, place, thing, or idea a proper noun gets more specific. It gives us the actual name of the person, place, thing, or idea. The actual names of people are proper nouns. So are the names of states, streets, rivers, oceans, countries, companies, institutions, churches, and more. Proper nouns are ALWAYS capitalized, but some nouns can be either proper or common (like addressing your "Dad" vs. talking about your dad).

For this activity, for each common noun try to come up with a unique proper noun that starts with each letter.
