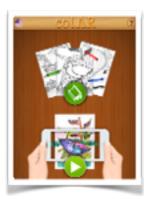


Genius Hour...

allows students to spend one class session per week working on an independent study of their choice. Your son/daughter will spend every Tuesday working on their Genius Hour topic. Please look through the documents I gave your son/daughter today to get a better sense of the project (these may also be accessed online at http://lmsplanner8.weebly.com/tech--media.html. Students will be required to choose an adult to serve as a mentor for them. You may wish to discuss project ideas and possible mentors (parents/grandparents/neighbors) together.

The second big piece of the class is the collaboration we will be doing with the 4th grade students at LES. Our class will be serving as mentors to these students as they begin their Genius Hour projects, as well. Fourth and eighth grade students will be paired up and our class will travel, via bus, to the elementary school once per week, typically Thursday's, to work (-over-)

Other notes:

- Students will be asked to do many creative projects throughout their 18 weeks in this course. Due to the creative nature of the class, students will be allowed to bring their iPod (or other music playing devices) and earbuds to class for the remainder of the course. Students will be asked to be respectful, responsible and safe with their use and will only be permitted to use them during work time after instruction has taken place. This is a privilege and may be taken away if it is abused.
- Grading for this course will be based on total points earned.
 Students will complete both individual and group projects.
 - + A = > 90%
 - + B = 80 89 %
 - + C = 70 79%
 - + D = 60 69%
- * Students earning less than a 60% on any given project will be asked to make corrections in order to achieve a minimum 60% score.

Eighth grade students will begin their Genius Hour projects within the next week. These projects should be large. I am asking students to "Dream Big". Students will have a total time of 27 weeks (18 weeks total within "Intro to Tech & Media" and 9 weeks in between our Tech & Media terms) to work on this project. This project is intended to be long-term, not something that can be completed in a matter of days or a couple of weeks.
